

Need for ICC Skilled General Practitioners & Health Professionals

- Shortage of 4,000+ Oncologists by 2020
- Cancer will impact 1 in 2 male and 1 in 3 female patients
- Number of new cases set to double by 2050
- Cancer death rates have decreased 20% from peak in 1991
- This roughly translates into 1.18 Million avoided deaths > cancer survivors
- 14 Million cancer survivors in the U.S., 19 Million by 2024
- Approximately 40% of survivors have been alive 10+ years post-diagnosis
